A20/Hermitage Lane

The Plan for the works on Hermitage Lane should be with KCC in February and those plans together with any plans for the Quick Win schemes on the A20 which would also be with

KCC at the same time, will be made available to the parishes. The plans for these have just arrived at the Council and the Clerk will report at the meeting.

Next KCC/TMBC/Parishes update meeting to be held in March/April.

- 4.3 Hall Road Motorway Bridge Broken Fencing and Litter Tracey Crouch MP has now taken this matter up with Highways England and is pursuing a response.
- 4.4 **Rochester Road Water** Any update on the second leak from Tottingham Farm pond overflow where the pipe appears to be blocked. Reported to Kent Highways and Southern Water as a potential hazard in icy conditions.
- 4.5 Hall Road Zebra Crossing Nearest A20 Have 'halos' been fitted.

Both Hall Road crossings have one beacon each not working. Reported to Highways.

- 6.1 River Medway Towpath MR 473 Work is progressing on this project due for completion by the end of March. BAM Compound set up on Yoakley paddock (adjacent to allotments on Forstal Road) using water supply from the allotments and will be contributing to costs.

This document was circulated to Members on 1 February to give an opportunity to read this document before this meeting so that the Council was in a position to comment by the deadline of 12 March. The Action Plan highlights five key actions which are

- To tackle the problem of overnight lorry parking in Kent
- To find a long term solution to Operation Stack
- To effectively manage the routeing of HGV traffic to ensure that such movements remain on the strategic road network for as much of its journey as possible
- To take steps to address the problems caused by freight traffic to communities
- To ensure that KCC continues to make effective use of planning and development control powers to reduce the impact of freight traffic

The document also highlights what needs to be done to implement the solutions to these problems.
