#### 4.5 TM/23/00003/TNCA - Church Barn 88 High Street Aylesford North

Sycamore Tree T1 (applicant ref) - fell and remove. Due to the proximity of to the ancient wall as well as uplifting the public footpath and being a trip hazard. Stump to be ground out. Sycamore Tree T2 (applicants ref) – remove all new growth back to stump. Poison stump using eco-plugs to prevent regrowth as it has caused damage to the footpath.

T1; Proposed comments – **Objection -** T1 is on the Public Footpath MR472. It is a mature tree which should be retained for its Landscape and environmental value.
