4. Planning Applications

4.1 TM/23/00992/FL – 52 Robson Drive Aylesford South

Subdivision of existing dwelling to create 2x 3 bed dwellings incorporating removal of existing front extension and reinstatement of front elevation with render and brick finish, new entrance door and window, part one/part two storey rear extension, three hipped roofs above new extensions and new parking area at front of dwelling.

It was **Resolved** to raise an **Objection**

The Parish Council did not raise an objection for the original application of the rear extension TM/23/00344/FL as it saw no direct adverse impact on neighbouring properties

as a result of the proposal as it was simply an extension. This revised application is for an additional three bed dwelling which will have very different implications for neighbouring properties.

The **Objections** are.

- Over development of the area.
- Not in keeping with the street scene.
- Totally inadequate off road parking provision for two three bed dwellings.
- Adverse impact on immediate neighbouring properties, as in effect it will be turning a semi-detached property into a terraced.
- The negatives of this proposal outweigh the 'need' for one additional dwelling.

4.2 TM/23/01054/TNCA - 45 Birch Crescent Aylesford South

Fell 1 x 10m tall Silver Birch - diseased with cream-coloured fungus growth.
