4.1 TM/21/01376/FL – 12 Thorn Close, Blue Bell Hill - Proposed Porch Extension

The Acting Clerk reported to members on the latest correspondence received from DHA Planning in the form of a Notice Under Article 13 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015 that was served to the Council as owner of the land that forms part of the application site. This is the same application as was submitted and subsequently withdrawn in 2020 due to some concerns raised by the Environment Agency. The Councils position and objection remains the same as previously submitted, there is currently some disagreement between the parties with regards to access and the Council has engaged its Solicitor to act in this regard.
