- 1. TM/13/00478 **218 Woodlands Road, Aylesford**

Erection of a two storey rear extension. Revised drawings 5th and 6th August received.

Parish Council Comments: No objection

2. TM/13/01510 Rosies Garden Plants, Rochester Road, Aylesford

Reserved matters application being details of layout, appearance, access, scale and landscaping pursuant to 12/02698 (Proposed permanent agricultural dwelling to supervise the horticultural enterprise at Ayleford Nursery in outline)

3. TM/13/02080 **58 Hurst Hill, Walderslade** (2 applications)

Two storey rear extension and revised plan received 6th August.

Parish Council Comments: No objection

4. TM/13/02199 8 Chippendale Close, Chatham

Coppice 2 ash trees in middle of group, remove one small beech and small ash extending over garden, and crown lift and thin crowns of 2 larger ash trees on each side of group. Amended proposal

Parish Council Comments: No objection

5. TM/13/02256 **7 The Beeches, Aylesford**

Erection of first floor extension

Parish Council Comments: No objection

6. TM/13/02308 41 Oakleigh Close, Walderslade

T1/T2 – crown lift two hornbeams to 4/5 metres and T3 and T4 – reduce overhanging branches to boundary line

Parish Council Comments: No objection

7. TM/13/02328 Unit 1, South Aylesford Retail Park, Quarry Wood, Aylesford

Retention of single non illuminated advertisement sign for 'Sharps'

8. TM/13/02340 Unit 19 Lake Road, Quarry Wood, Aylesford

Removal of existing fence to side boundary and replacement with new

Parish Council Comments: No objection

9. TM/13/02513 182 Robin Hood Lane, Walderslade

All trees identified are to be reduced and trimmed back, as some branches are overhanging public footpaths, telephone lines and adjacent properties. The trees have dropped branches in recent high winds. We have already been in contact with the tree planning officer regarding the silver birches which required emergency felling as they were both rotten and diseased. They were dropping branches in high winds and this was undertaken to prevent damage to property.

Parish Council Comments: No objection provided work is overseen by Tree Officer.

10. TM/13/02517 5 Holtwood Avenue, Aylesford

Reduce the height of 3 no. leylandis by 20% and remove branches hanging on garage and remove 1 no. dead hawthorn

Parish Council Comments: No objection

11. TM/13/02535 Land east of A20 and South of St Laurence Avenue, Allington

Non material amendment to TM/13/00342 to swap the location of the door and window on the western elevation

Parish Council Comments: No objection

Change of use of land from pub car park to B8 (storage yard), erection of fencing and enlargement of access

Parish Council Comments: Strong objection. This proposal is not in keeping with the local amenity area. It would be a complete eyesore within an area of outstanding natural beauty.

13. TM/13/02563 14 Birch Crescent, Aylesford

(T1-T3) sweet chestnut – Raise lower crowns to approx. 9 metres and remove deadwood. T4-T5 sweet chestnuts – cut back from property by approx. 3 metres. T6 silver birch – dismantle to grown level. T7 small conifer – dismantle to grown level.

Members agreed a positive response to this consultation based on the following reasons:

One tarmac runway will enable planes to take off and gain height more quickly thus reducing noise levels for local residents and opposed to the existing two grass runways.

Establishment of a new industrial estate will provide local jobs within an already existing industrial area

The airport has been open since 1933 and these proposals will secure the long term future of the airport and the remaining open space around it.
