(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER NOVEMBER 2020

To allow junction improvement works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on Kits Coty Slip Northbound Off & Kits Coty Slip Southbound Off, Aylesford.

Closures are planned from 14th November 2020, between the hours of 19:30 and 05:30, with estimated completion by 18th November 2020, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE40190201201-1 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on [one.network](#)

The following roads will be closed in turn, with only one road closed at a time, as detailed below.

Kits Coty Slip Northbound Off will be closed between the junctions with Old Chatham Road and Rochester Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A229 Blue Bell Hill, Blue Bell Hill Slip North Off, Lord Lees Roundabout, Blue Bell Hill Slip South On, A229 Blue Bell Hill and Kits Coty Slip Southbound Off.

Kits Coty Slip Southbound Off will be closed between the junctions with A229 Blue Bell Hill and Lower Warren Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via A229 Blue Bell Hill, Chatham Road, Cobtree Roundabout, Chatham Road, A229 Blue Bell Hill and Kits Coty Slip Northbound Off.

It will also be necessary to impose a temporary mandatory 40 mph speed restriction on Rochester Road between the junctions with Kits Coty Slip Northbound Off and Kits Coty Slip Southbound Off.

The restrictions are required for the safety of the public and workforce while junction improvement works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
